## Zion at Prayer

A Guide for Daily Meditation and Prayer  
Fifth Sunday of Easter – May 20-26, 2019

Pray and confess out loud as much as you are able, or as your family size and ages dictate. Learn by heart the verse, catechism, and hymn of the week.

**Verse:** Romans 6:9; John 14:23

**Alleluia. We know that Christ being raised from the dead will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. Alleluia. If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Alleluia.**

**The Catechism:** As the head of the family should teach in a simple way to his household:

<b>The Sacrament of Holy Baptism – Second Section</b>
<b>What benefits does Baptism give?</b>
It works forgiveness of sins, rescues from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe this, as the words and promises of God declare.
<b>Which are these words and promises of God?</b>
Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Mark, “Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.” Mark 16:16
